

Year 1: Drawing



Core content:

Explore mark making – create a range of marks using different media on a surface.

Technical vocabulary:

Cross-hatching – drawing a series of parallel lines to create tonal effects.



Monochrome – using shades of one colour (in this case, black and white).



Orientation – the direction in which lines are drawn.



Surface – the flat area of paper or canvas.



Texture – how rough or smooth a surface is.



Drawing – creating a range of marks on a surface.

Year 1: Mechanisms
How do you make a picture move?



Core content:

Investigate how sliders work.
Design and make a card slider product.

Technical vocabulary:

Slider – a rigid bar which moves backwards and forwards along a straight line.



Slot – a narrow cut which a slider can pass through.



Bridge – rectangles cut from rigid material and stuck to the surface which the slider passes under.



Push – a force to move something away from you.



Pull – a force to move something closer to you.



Rigid – stiff and difficult to move or bend
